THESE buxom beauties from South Sea Roller Derby are getting their bras out in the open this weekend, all in the name of a good cause.

The derby girls will take part in BRAmageddon, a bout in Keysborough to raise money for Project Uplift, an organisation which

sends bras to women in third world countries.

Erin Beckett — who goes by the derby name Titasaurus — chose the charity for the event and said as a big-busted woman she understood the need for good bras.

"I found the charity

online and I thought it was something unusual and also very accessible for women because we all have bras we

don't use," Beckett said. "It's important to have a decent fitting bra and a lot of people can't imagine not having access to one at all.

"In a lot of these com-

munities (where the bras are sent) it is hot and humid and if they don't have bras to lift them up they can get abscesses and infections where the skin rubs.'

Spectators are asked to bring along any spare bras to donate to the project, with \$1 from all ticket sales also going to the charity. The bout will be held at

Springers Leisure Centre, 400 Cheltenham Rd, Keysborough on Saturday from 6pm. Tickets are \$10 for adults and \$5 for children. Find out more about BRAmageddon at southsearollerderby.com
